The original of the report must be received by the Hass Avocado Board, with full remittance, no later than the last business day of the month within 30 days after the end of the month in which the sale or non-sale transfer subject to assessments under the Hass Avocado Promotion, Research, and Information Order (7 CFR Part 1219). A late payment penalty and an interest charge will be applied to assessments that are delinquent. All reports are held in strict confidence by the staff of the Hass Avocado Board and the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

**NOTE:** The statements on the reverse are made in accordance with the Privacy Act of 1974 (U.S.C. §522a) and the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995, as amended. The authority for requesting this information to be supplied on this form is from the applicable commodity legislation for research and promotion programs.
